MARCH SHOW

SHOW INFORMATION

This show is open to Exhibiting Artist Members. Show coordinators will hang the artwork using a gallery style format. As a guideline each artist has space equivalent to about 90" width by 50" height. Most 2D work will be hung on wood panels, 35" wide x 66" high, 1-4 works per panel. 3D artists will have counter and pedestal space equivalent to 90" wide. There is limited wall space for art larger than 30" wide. If you have more work than space allows, coordinators will contact you to pick it up Wednesday afternoon or Thursday morning; as there is no storage space for it, and if more work is needed, they will contact artists. Please remove all packaging when you check your art in on Wednesday morning. Artists with small items are present during show hours with their work in one place, and keep their own inventory list. If you have cards or unframed prints, these are displayed in a rack or basket near the cashier desk and must have a price sticker on each.

SCHEDULE

Wednesday March 11, 10:30-12:30:

Check in artwork. Do not bring work early. Work not checked in by Wednesday will not be hung.

Thursday March 12, 5-7pm:

Members Reception - All artists are expected to attend for the duration.

Friday-Saturday 10-5 and Sunday 10-4 - Show continues

Each artist is assigned at least one gallery shift; see shift form. If you cannot be there for a shift, contact Babs Vanyo, Show Committee Chair, prior to show to arrange for a substitute. Show breakdown starts as soon as the show is officially closed by the coordinators at 4:00. All artists are expected to be there to pick up unsold work and help with breakdown.

ADDITIONAL SHOW GUIDELINES (Also see Show Policies)

- Paintings must be DRY and framed or gallery-wrapped with a WIRE on the back for hanging. Sawtooth hangers don't work with our system. No bare canvas or staples should be visible.
- Works on paper must be framed under glass or acrylic with a WIRE on the back.
- Any work that is sold before the show opens must be labeled NFS. NO RED DOTS are to be on any work before the show opens. When work is sold, the wall tag is removed and put in the office.
- If more work is needed, show coordinators will contact artists to see if more is available.
- There is a 15% commission on all Exhibiting Member sales.
